- 6. We will review and comment San Francisco Declaration on Research Assessment on a document in our box folder. We will vote on a memo related to it at our next meeting.
- 7. We agreed that AVLSCE resources are available to help us understand complex issues including budget but that our general approach is get that help on an as-needed basis rather than invite outside speakers to our meetings.
